She didn't, and considering the rumors about the stable boy, I didn't think it tactful to ask. Now, I reread the brief item about Daphne's accident . . . what began to bother me after yet another reading was the part that Daphne "is now out of danger." If so, what exactly had she been in danger of?"
